

Promethean Board Instructions for Tech Talk Presenter



Turning on the projector, if necessary...

We will turn the projectors on in the morning. A solid blue light indicate that the projector is on. An Amber or yellow light indicated the projector is in sleep mode.



Indicator light



If the projector is in sleep mode (amber light), point the remote control at the black window on the projector and press the power button.

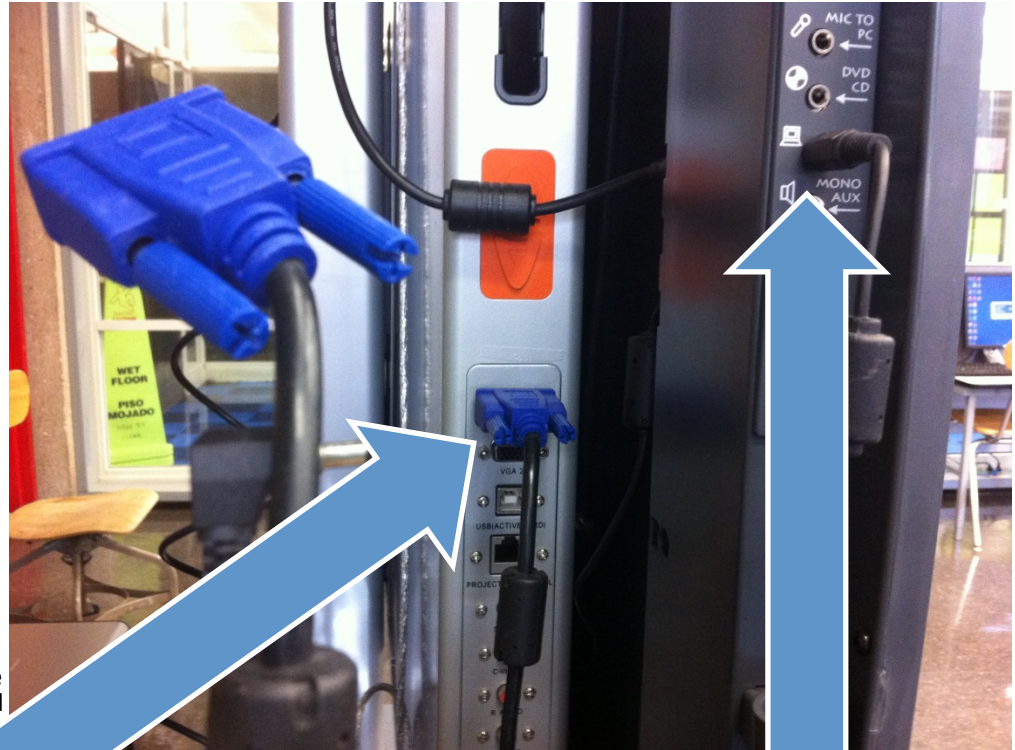


Black Window

Power Button



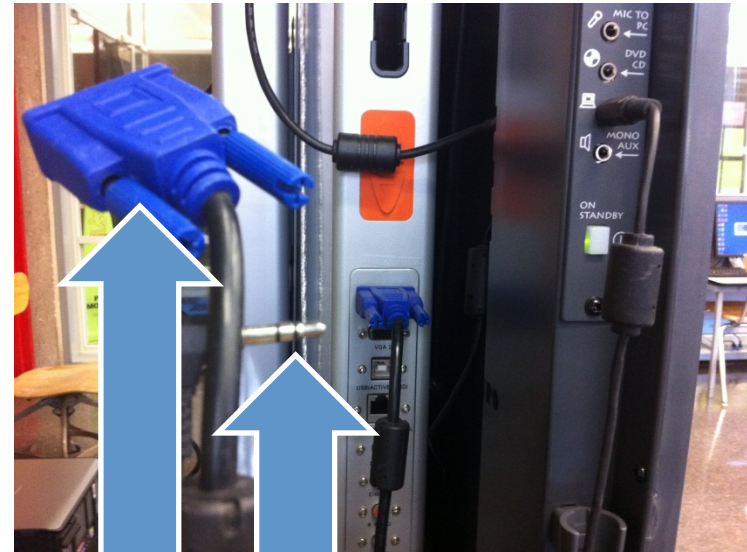
- There will be a VGA cable and audio cable plugged into the board.

- You will take the other end of both cables and connect them to your laptop. If your presentation doesn't have audio, you do not need to connect the audio cable.

The Projector should auto-detect your laptop and display it on the screen. As you are probably aware, depending on your laptop, you may have to hold down “CTRL” key and press “F8” or another function key to send the video out through the external VGA port.
